Despite the additional demands, he continues to dominate the world of snocross and most recently captured the FIM Snowcross World Championship in Mala, Sweden this past April.

“This is a great opportunity to give my fans an inside look at not just my personal life but the entire team,” said Hibbert. “I work with an amazing and talented group of people who have had an incredible impact on not only me but the entire industry. Racing is a team sport and I think it will be interesting to give fans a look at what it takes to compete at this level.”
