Jan. 4, 2011 – Monster Energy/Arctic Cat's Tucker Hibbert will enter round three of the AMSOIL Championship Snocross Series (ACSS) near Salt Lake City on Saturday undefeated for the season but has something to prove. Last year at the Piranha X Western National, Hibbert's 15 national race win streak was broken after a seventh place finish in the Pro Open class. For the second consecutive year, Sandy's Rio Tinto Stadium will be transformed from a professional soccer field into a tight, rough snocross course. Last year's track proved to be difficult for Hibbert who is known for his super-smooth, mistake-free riding style.
